

# Photo exhibition of the interfaith youth exchange Bridge-Inter-Cultures was presented at the Bulgarian Parliament

The official opening of a photo exhibition dedicated to the Bridge-Inter-Cultures cooperation project of URI Europe and Arigatou International took place in Sofia, in the National Assembly of Bulgaria. The initiative, which aims to promote understanding, intercultural and religious tolerance, gather together teenagers of different ethnicities and religious background.

The third edition featured international participation with children from Bulgaria and the Netherlands and in collaboration between URI Europe and, Arigatou International. After Stara Zagora, the children visited The Hague where the second part of the camp took place. Honorary guests of the event were Mala and Bart from URI the Netherlands and the children who took part in the initiative arriving from different corners of the country.

At the opening of the exhibition, which was carried out with the support of Deputy Speaker of the National Assembly Mr. Emil Hristov, there were religious leaders from different faiths as well as representatives of the Dutch partners and co-organizers of the project - URI Netherlands CC.

Bridge-Inter-Cultures-Bridges will take its course not only as a series of camps for children and youth but also as a traveling exhibition in Bulgaria and abroad.
